Suggested Itinerary

SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO

Day 1

Arrival + Lunch or Coffee

Welcome to Santa Fe! Settle into your lodging, and depending on your arrival time, get lunch at The Shed for some classic New Mexican cuisine or grab coffee near the Plaza at Iconik Coffee Roasters or 35° North.

Wander the Plaza

There are several shops, galleries, and museums in Santa Fe's historic Plaza area. Peruse the portal of the Palace of the Governors for a selection of Native-made jewelry, and don't miss Shiprock, Antieau Gallery, and Andrea Fisher Fine Pottery. (If you prefer, let us show you around on our Plaza Art + Architecture tour!)

Drinks + Dinner

Before dinner, toast to the bride at Gruet Winer Tasting Room, Tonic, or Secreto Lounge. Then head to nearby Coyote Cafe for an upscale celebratory dinner. Want a more laid back atmosphere? Try the rooftop Coyote Cantina instead!

Day 2

O'Keeffe Museum & Lunch

Start the morning at the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum to learn more about this iconic artist. O'Keeffe fell in love with Northern New Mexico and painted many desert landscapes. Then, enjoy lunch in the Plaza area at the Plaza Cafe or Cafe Pasqual's.

Tour Canyon Road with SFAT

After lunch, tour Canyon Road with Santa Fe Art Tours and take in the ambiance of this charming arts district. Or, you might opt for our Art Tour + Chocolate Elixir Tasting instead, so that you can try the sumptuous elixirs at Kakawa Chocolate House!

Happy Hour + Dinner

If you're on Canyon Road after your tour, check out happy hour at El Farol. Or, come back a little later for the Flamenco dinner show. If you opt for dinner near the Plaza, head to Sazón for a fine dining experience, the patio at La Casa Sena for ambiance, or The Cowgirl for casual fun.

Day 3

Morning Hike

Head up Canyon Road to the Cerro Gordo (Dale Ball) Trailhead, where you'll have a few options for hikes. For a climb with views, head to the top of Pichaco Peak. For an easy stroll along babbling streams and marshes in the foothills, hike the Santa Fe Canyon Preserve trail.

Lunch at the Teahouse

After your hike, head back down Canyon Road to The Teahouse for lunch. Afterward, pop by Cielo Handcrafted across the street for a cute souvenir to take home with you.

Soak + Spa

In the afternoon, head to Ten Thousand Waves, a Japanese inspired spa tucked among the pines. Book a private hot tub suite for a lovely experience just for your group. A wonderful way to relax and wind down at the end of your stay in Santa Fe!
